LENT 2010

FairTrade – TradeCraft

Traidcraft's links with the church have been stressed in two major presentations – to the General Synod of the Church of England, and to the Methodist Conference – by Traidcraft Chief Executive Paul Chandler. Here, he sets out his core message: Traidcraft was founded 30 years ago as a Christian response to the scandal of world poverty and as a practical action towards establishing justice in the world of trade. From our first transactions with craftspeople in a handful of villages, Traidcraft – with the support of churches across the UK – has grown to deal with over 100 producer groups in 30 different countries. The fair trade movement, which we helped establish, now provides support to some seven million producers, bringing hope and opportunity where little existed before.
